

Market Rules Borrekaupangen

Violation of the rules may result in expulsion from this or later markets.

Arrival and departure

- 🚧 First arrival Monday at 8:00 a.m. last Thursday at 3:00 p.m.
 - 🕒 When you arrive at the market, sign in with the site manager. He or she will show you your place and give you the necessary information.
 - 🕒 Complaining about the place you get for your tent is prohibited. If you have specific wishes and needs, you must notify the market management when you sign up for the market.
 - 🕒 All cars must be out of the market at 5.00 p.m. Thursday. We strive for authenticity in the market area.
 - 🕒 Arrival on market days is only possible if arranged in advance. No cars will be allowed driving into the area between the hours 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. (5.00 p.m.)
 - 🕒 Park your car(s) only in designated places. Parking facilities are better than ever.
- 🚧 Opening hours for the public is Friday to Sunday. 11.00 a.m. 6.00 p.m. (5.00 p.m.)

Clothing

- 🚧 Viking age
 - 🕒 It is required to always have authentic Viking clothing.
 - 🕒 If this is your first market and you do not have proper clothes, ask for help.
 - 🕒 Going swimming? Use your Viking swimsuits (linen) and use your linen towel or change to swimsuit at the beach.
 - 🕒 You don't have Viking shoes? Buy some or make your own. Go barefoot or use neutral modern shoes ...
 - 🕒 Modern tattoos should be hidden as much as possible.

Equipment and furniture

- 🚧 During the market all modern plastic must be hidden. **We do not allow visible plastic.**
 - 🕒 Use cup, glass or horn.
 - 🕒 During the market, we encourage everyone to use furniture, chairs and other camping equipment that is historically accurate.
- 🚧 The gala dinner on Saturday evening:
 - 🕒 Bring your historical eating utensil.
 - 🕒 Fill the cup, glass, or horn in your tent, or very discreet at the dining area. We would prefer that beer cans and wine bottles are not visible.
 - 🕒 Borre National Park is a public space. If the police see us drinking at the beach, they might close the whole market.

Alcohol and Drugs.

- 🚧 Drugs that are in violation of Norwegian criminal law are (of course) prohibited.
- 🚧 Alcohol and drunkenness are prohibited under the market's opening hours.
- 🚧 Persons under 18 years is according to Norwegian law not allowed to drink alcohol

Generally

- 🚒 After opening hours only registered Vikings are allowed in the market area.
- 🚒 Dogs should be seen, not heard.
 - 🐾 All dogs must always be in a leash, and bitches on heat are not allowed at the market.
 - 🐾 Walking of dogs shall, for hygienic reasons, occur outside the market area.
- 🚒 Smoke from bonfires, snoring, singing, music and rain must be expected on a Viking market.
 - 🐾 Evening and night drumming must take place in the burial mounds area, not in the market area.
- 🚒 In your tent, there should be at least one approved fire extinguisher, and it should be placed so that it is easy to find, preferably close to the opening – right side when facing opening from the outside.
 - 🐾 Open fire is of course not allowed inside the tent.
- 🚒 Don't get more firewood than you need for each day.
- 🚒 You should already have read and accepted the rules of the market when applying. When you arrive, go to the Chieftain of Borre Vikinglag or to the site manager and say "Eplekake" Then we know that you have read the rules and that you are ready to enjoy Borrekaupangen 2026.
